- Applicant must submit two Letters of Recommendations by adults, teachers, or organization leaders with whom the applicant has worked closely. At least ONE of these recommendations must come from a Core Subject Teacher.
- Applicant must include an introduction letter addressed to the LVEF Scholarship Committee that introduces themselves and why this scholarship would be of value to them.
- Applicant must submit the application cover sheet, introduction Letter, answers to the short
  answers and essay question, and two letters of recommendations in a sealed manila envelope to
  the LVISD Central Office marked for the La Vernia Education Foundation, no later than 3pm on
  April 4, 2020.
